SCHOOL ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Yearbooks are on sale in the library. Yearbooks cost \$76.50 with personalization and \$70 without personalization.
- Senior ads for the yearbook are on sale in the library. Full-page senior ads cost \$200 with a yearbook included. Half-page ads are \$100. $\frac{1}{4}$ page ads are \$50. The deadline to order senior ads is February 28^{th} .
- All juniors take the ACT in March as part of state testing. Students will know the day they are testing on March 1st.
- Kentucky state law requires school staff to check attendance and grades from the previous semester before providing the required driver's permit paper. Students must pass at least 4 out of 6 classes and miss fewer than 9 unexcused days to obtain the required paper. Students register for permit testing at https://kentuckystatepolice.org/.
- -Drivers whose permits were issued under age 18 must complete a driver education program before moving to the full, unrestricted licensing phase. Students can sign up for the training offered on March 24th at Clay County High School at https://aliveat25.us/ky/course-info?course_id=13139.
- <u>Seniors If your FAFSA is not completed and you need help, please contact guidance staff to set up a time for completion.</u>
- The next national ACT date in April 2nd. Students register for the ACT at <u>my.act.org</u>. Many juniors and seniors qualify for FOUR free exams. The exam fee is \$60. Sign up for ACT (no writing). The registration deadline is Feb. 25th.
- -IMPORTANT: Students who want to take college classes offered at CCHS next year must earn the required ACT scores to enroll in the classes. English (for seniors) requires an 18 in English or 20 in reading. College Algebra requires a 19 in math. Statistics requires a 23 in math. Calculus requires a 27 in math.

- Scholarship applications and deadlines are emailed to seniors.

- <u>Kay Campbell Nursing Scholarship</u> (**\$3000**) Deadline to apply is March 7th.
